

HIGHWAY LEGAL STOCK 4-WHEEL DRIVE TRUCK PULL RULES

IT IS HIGHLY RECOMMENDED THAT YOU READ AND UNDERSTAND ALL OF THE RULES BEFORE YOU ENTER

NO ALCOHOL ALLOWED IN PITS. POSSESSION OF OR CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOL AND/OR DRUGS BY DRIVER OR ANY PIT MEMBER WILL RESULT IN DRIVER AND TRUCK BEING DISQUALIFIED AND REMOVED FROM FAIRGROUNDS. ALL ENTRY MONEY, PIT FEES AND/OR PRIZE MONEY WILL BE FORFEITED.

ENTRY:

- 1 - Entry fee is \$30 per truck in Gas Powered and Diesel Powered Classes. Two Pit Passes are included with entry fee.
- 2 - Gas Powered and Diesel Powered Classes will be open to all manufacturers.

VEHICLE ELIGIBILITY:

- 1 - 4 Wheel Drive Trucks, both Pickup and SUV types are allowed to compete. Street stock production trucks considered as a mass-produced truck, which came off an assembly line and is street legal. No certified pulling trucks.
- 2 - Truck must be licensed, highway legal and shall have been driven to event. All competitors must have current proof of insurance.
- 3 - Gas Powered Trucks must have same make engine as truck chassis. Gas engines must be naturally aspirated, single carb, or factory fuel injected, no dominators or dominator style. No nitrous oxide or LP add-on will be allowed for any vehicle. Diesel trucks limited to one turbo, turbo must be stock appearing.
- 4 - OEM intake and exhaust manifolds. Carburetors must have a cast iron intake. Fuel injection must have stock appearing intake. No aftermarket aluminum heads allowed. Headers will be allowed. All exhaust systems must be of closed type and exit behind the truck cab.
- 5 - No bar tires or cut tires will be allowed. All tires must be street legal DOT approved no larger than 33 x 12.5 inches. Maximum wheel size 21 inches.
- 6 - Factory duals will be allowed.
- 7 - No traction or ladder bars on front or rear. No blocked suspension. Air bag suspension must be deflated.
- 8 - Truck must be clean and empty, no loose items in truck box or cab. No farm type fuel tanks will be allowed. Trucks cannot be gutted or stripped in any way.
- 9 - All trucks must not exceed the maximum weight requirement for the class. Maximum weight will include the operator.
Gas Powered Class maximum weight is 6800 lbs. Diesel Powered Class maximum weight is 8000 lbs.
- 10 - Weights added must be located between front and rear bumpers. No extension of bumpers allowed. All added weights must be secured. No loose weight allowed. No liquid allowed for weight. No added weight allowed in cab of truck. Any weight lost while pull is in progress will be cause for disqualification. All added weight subject to inspection and approval by pull officials.
- 11 - It is recommended that trucks be equipped with at least two chains/cables per drive shaft bolted to truck frame. Chain/cable loops should be equally spaced from universal joints. Chains/cables should be of adequate strength to support shaft in event of breakage. Cables should be ¼ inch diameter minimum. Permanently attached steel shaft cages will be allowed.
- 12 - Trucks must be inspected and weighed before drivers meeting. Once truck has been inspected, weighed and approved no alterations can be made. If truck has not been inspected, weighed and approved, truck will not be allowed to compete. Arrive early to ensure inspection. No truck will be allowed to leave pit area after inspection until pull is complete.

HITCHING / HOOKING REQUIREMENTS:

- 1 - No competition type pulling hitches will be allowed. Hitch must be stock bumper or Reese type.
- 2 - Maximum hitch height is 26 inches.
- 3 - Each contestant must supply own clevis with a minimum three (3) inch opening. Clevis can be straight or twisted type.
- 4 - Clevis pin must be mounted through hitch hole. Minimum clevis pin diameter is three quarter (3/4) inch.

DRIVER REQUIREMENTS:

- 1 - Driver must have valid drivers license.
- 2 - ISP membership is not required.
- 3 - Pit passes will be required of all drivers and crewmembers to enter pits. Pit passes are revocable without refund at the discretion of Grundy County Fair without cause for liability on the Fairs part. Drivers and crewmembers that are eliminated may go to grandstand by surrendering pit pass for admission. Beer stand will not serve anyone with pit pass.
- 4 - DOT approved full-face helmet and seatbelt must be worn. All pullers must wear shirt, long pants and shoes before they will be allowed to compete.
- 5 - All drivers must attend mandatory drivers meeting to be held at announced time the day of the event. Drivers only, not crew members.
- 6 - All vehicles will be operated in a safe manner at all times within the confines of the pits, staging areas and on the track.
- 7 - If contestant or crewmember disobeys an official or knowingly disregards a rule, that contestant shall be disqualified, forfeit all monies and shall be requested to leave.

SUMMARY OF REASONS FOR DISQUALIFICATION:

- 1 - Failure to wear DOT approved full-face helmet or seat belt, loss of safety equipment and/or failure of safety equipment.
- 2 - Leaving starting line under red flag or failure to observe and/or obey red flag.
- 3 - If vehicle goes out of bounds when hooked to sled, the vehicle will be disqualified. Test puller exempt from this rule.
- 4 - Excessive loss of liquid on the track as determined by track Judge when under the green flag
- 5 - In case of any parts lost that could be a safety problem or create an advantage, then pull shall be terminated.
- 6 - Unsafe equipment.
- 7 - Unsportsmanlike conduct or disrespect on the part of a competitor or a member of his/her crew.
- 8 - The decision of the track Judge is final and shall not be appealable, provided however that with a showing of reasonable and good cause the Track Judge may, without liability, reverse or revise his decision.
- 9 - Unsafe operation of competition vehicle anywhere within confines of track, pit area or on event grounds. **DO NOT USE EXCESSIVE SPEED THRU PIT AREA OR ON TRACK. RECKLESS DRIVING OR EXCESSIVE SPEED ON ASPHALT SPEEDWAY ABSOLUTELY WILL NOT BE CONDONED AND MAY RESULT IN CHARGES BEING FILED.** The determination of speeding and or reckless driving shall rest solely with the Grundy County Fair Board or it's designated representative.
- 10 - **NO ALCOHOL ALLOWED IN PITS.** Possession of or consumption of alcohol and/or drugs by driver or any pit member will result in driver and truck being disqualified and removed from fairgrounds. Violation will result in forfeiture of all entry money, pit fees and/or prize money.

The Grundy County Agricultural District Fair Association reserves the final and absolute right to interpret these rules and regulations and to arbitrarily settle and determine all matters, questions or differences in regard thereto. The Grundy County Agricultural District Fair Association shall further reserve the right to amend or add to these rules when in its judgment, it may so determine as necessary. The Grundy County Agricultural District Fair Association further reserves the right to withdraw any premium offerings, whether in whole or part should circumstances demand. Grundy County Agricultural District Fair Association assumes absolutely no responsibility for personal injury or loss or damage to personal property.
